Nzove Water Treatment Plant in Nzove cell, Kanyinya Sector, Nyarugenge District

Production Capacity

Phase 1- We started with commissioning 25,000m³/day water treatment plant in March 2016 to increase production from

65,000m³ to 90.000m³/day in Kigali

against the demand which is 120,000m³/day

Phase 2 which will be commissioned in July this year will add 55,000m³/day to have the total capacity of 145,000m³/day.

The progress for Phase 2 works is currently at 40% and should completely cover demand for Kigali.

Phase 2 involves upgrading production capacity of the existing 25,000m³/day to 40,000m³/day and construction of a new treatment plant with initial capacity of 40,000m³/day with upgradable capacity of 65,000m³/day when demand increases in future.



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Process of supplying water

Treated water is pumped from Nzove 1 to Ntora reservoir (capacity of 10,000 cubic meters), located at Gisozi. From the reservoir, water is distributed to customers in Kigali.
